SPECIAL OLYMPICS PA – PHILADELPHIA TO HOLD THIRD ANNUAL ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL IUS BOCCE CHAMPIONSHIP AT JEFFERSON UNIVERSITY ON JANUARY 9

3 Philadelphia Elementary Schools & 5 Philadelphia Middle Schools to compete in Bocce Championship

(PHILADELPHIA, PA – January 3, 2018) - The third annual Elementary/Middle School IUS Bocce Championship, hosted by Special Olympics Pennsylvania's Philadelphia local program (SOPA-Philly), is set to occur on Tuesday, January 9, 2018. The Elementary/Middle School IUS Bocce Championship will take place at Jefferson University's Gallagher Recreation Center, located at 4201 Henry Avenue in Philadelphia. Teams will compete between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm.

Elementary schools in attendance will be Juniata Park Academy, Penrose School, and Universal Daroff Charter School. Middle schools in attedance will be Andrew Hamilton, Hill-Freedman World Avademy, Middle Years Alternative School, Penrose School, and Universal Daroff Charter School.

This year, Special Olympics PA – Philadelphia welcomes the largest amount of teams to date – a total of fifteen schools. This is also the first year that Jefferson University is hosting the Elementary/Middle School IUS Bocce Championship. Jefferson students and student athletes will serve as volunteers for the day, assisting with set-up, timing, scorekeeping and officiating.

SOPA-Philly invites the public to come watch the transformative power of sports as elementary and middle school students with intellectual disabilities (athletes) and students without intellectual disabilities (partners) take their skills to the championship after training together for months.
